Pastel on Brown Paper Painting

1. Hard stick pastels in following colors:

Prismacolor Nupastel are nice

Primary colors - red, yellow, blue

Secondary colors - orange, green, purple

Tertiary Colors - red-orange, yellow-orange, yellow-green, blue-green, blue-violet and red-violet

Earth colors - browns and reddish-browns

One stick ea. - black, white and a few grays

A few soft stick pastels in various colors - if you use them

Pastel Pencils in a few colors

2. A board larger than your art paper (Masonite is nice but if you do not have Masonite board, two or three pieces of equal-size cardboard taped together makes a nice inexpensive board to place your paper) NOTE: no creases under paper surface.

3. Artist tape or painter's tape (green frog tape or similar)

4. An old face towel

5. Kneaded Eraser

6. Tracing paper - piece large enough to cover work

7. Plastic Container (sandwich size) filled half way with uncooked white rice
