

Sculpting Workshop Tool list for Katherine Mathisen

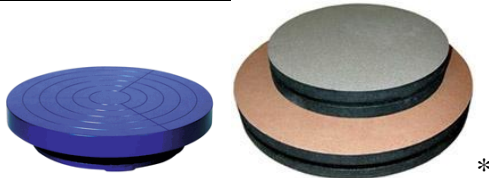
If you have any of the following clay hand-building tools bring them. I will have a limited quantity of tools to share. Photos are examples:

Bright type brush. Flat with edges curved inward at tip, with shortish hairs.

Terrycloth hand towel comes in handy to wipe your hands off. So much better than paper towels. Find an old one you don't care about it will now be a clay stained rag.
