

Hurlbut, Watercolor Painting Supply List

- 1 Full Sheet of Arches 140 lb. Cold Press Watercolor Paper cut into 1/4 sheets (or a watercolor block of student's choice).
- Gator Board (or foam core)
- 2 large clips or painters tape
- Sketchbook (no smaller than 5"x8")
- Value Sketch Pens or drawing pencils
- Kneaded eraser
- Brushes: 2" flat, 1" flat, #14 Round, #12 Round and assorted detail brushes (natural or synthetic bristles are fine); An old toothbrush is good for spattering and lifting.
- Palette knife
- Paper towels and tissues (cheap ones are best)
- Sponge
- One or two old hand towels
- Water well (plastic that holds one quart of water is fine)
- Water spray bottle with fine spray nozzle (old hair spray bottles work well)
- Watercolor palette with cover
- Watercolor Paints in tubes: Suggested colors include
 - Cobalt Blue
 - French Ultramarine
 - Hookers Green
 - Opera Rose
 - Raw Sienna
 - Viridian Green
 - Windsor Yellow
 - Rose Madder

I prefer Windsor Newton or Holbien for their pigment quality, but the students may use their favorite colors/brands.
